BrightHaven is a Santa Rosa, CA based 501(c)(3) animal welfare organization providing rescue, hospice and holistic education, with an emphasis on senior, disabled and chronically ill animals.

Since 1990, BrightHaven has evolved into a unique holistic healing arts and education center. Its rescue arm helps shelter animals most at risk for euthanasia.

Co-founders Gail and Richard Pope received the Jefferson Award for public service in July 2013 in acknowledgment of their service to the vulnerable population of senior, disabled and chronically ill animals and for providing sanctuary to animals facing certain death.
